MEMORANDUM

Sub: Extension of scope of family pension to un-married daughters of the deceased employees/ Pensioners of Government of sponsored Public Libraries/Aided Libraries towards their admissibility of family pension:

As per existing provisions of West Bengal Recognised Non-Govt. Educational institution Employees DCRB Scheme, 1981 issued vide School Education Department Memo No. 136-Edn(B) dated 15.05.1985 read with Mass Education Extension and Library Services Department Memo No. 1182/MEE/Sectt. Dated 17.11.2009 unmarried daughters of the approved and whole time deceased employees/ pensioners of Government sponsored Public Libraries/Aided Libraries under the administrative control of this Department are eligible for grant of family pension till they attain the age of 25 years or up to the date of their marriage whichever is earlier.

After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to decide in respect of the un-married daughters of the deceased employees (appointed on regular/substantive basis against sanctioned posts) / pensioners of Government of sponsored Public libraries/ Aided Libraries under the administrative control of this Department under West Bengal Recognized Non-Government Educational Institution Employees DCRB Scheme, 1981 the benefit of family pension shall be allowed even after attaining the age of 25 years till their marriage or death whichever is earlier subject to the condition that the applicant /incumbent has monthly income less than Rs. 3,500/- from any employment in Government, Semi Government, Statutory Bodies, Corporation, Private sector, Self employment etc. salary/ Income Certificate may be obtained from the employer in case where the incumbent is under the employment in Government / Semi Government / Corporation / Private Sector etc. In case they are self employed or are in receipt of income from sources other than employment, any Central Government Gazetted Officer/ State Government Officer belonging to Group A service shall be the competent authority to issue such income certificate.

Formal amendment to the relevant Scheme will be made in due course.

This benefit will be effective from the date of issue of this Memorandum.



MEMORANDUM


A proposal of formation of a Committee for IEC (Information, Education & Communication) was under consideration of the government for some time past.

Now, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that after careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to form a Committee for IEC (Information, Education & Communication) under the Chairperson-ship of the Director of Mass Education Extension, West Bengal comprising of the following Officers :

1. Director of Mass Education Extension, West Bengal
2. Director of Library Services, West Bengal
3. Joint Director of Mass Education Extension, West Bengal
4. Assistant Director of Library Services, West Bengal

The functions of the Committee will be as follows:-

- a. Considering the level and size of the mela and/or publication, benchmarks may be prepared.
- b. Upon fixing the benchmark, amount of contribution may be decided which may vary from Rs.5000/- to Rs.50,000/- depending on the range of the mela and/or publication.
- c. All applications for such contributions, as stated above, for the purpose of generating public awareness in respect of the activities of the department, shall be judged by the Committee according to merit and recommended for payment.
- d. Orders of the Hon'ble Minister of State (IC), in such cases, will be routed through this Committee.
